EUTOPIA MORE Autumn School 2024 as part of the EUTOPIA INCLUSION MONTH

EUTOPIA MORE has dedicated the month of November 2024 as the Inclusion month. Continuing with the EUTOPIA member universities' commitment to speak, teach, promote and raise awareness as concerns the topic of inclusion and diversity in our academic and broader social worlds, University of Ljubljana contributes to this task by EUTOPIA MORE School which looks at the interconnectedness and co-dependency between inclusion and the emerging ecologies of climate change. Our goal is to open up a fresh debate on how inclusion, as an ethos and a civic practice, is affected by the planetary ecological catastrophes, wheather-caused crises and environmental degradations. To this, we add the dimension of technological advances, with digitalization and AI taking the prime seat in defining our societies as well as public deliberation about the future and inclusion. Hence the title: "ecological intelligence".

The school brings together renown scholars of diverse theoretical and disciplinary background, with a special focus on the role of humanities in thinking about diversity, minorities, vulnerable subjects, but also new agencies amidst a joint impact of (disturbed) ecology and (artificial) intelligence. Participants will gain new knowledge in the field of environmental humanities, digitalization and society, and learn innovative practical methods of transformative arts and social sciences.

The school is open primarily to MA and PhD students with some prior knowledge of social theory and communication/digitalization studies, and who are interested in new interdisciplinary approaches to their study and research.
