- Step 1: Visit http://www.csc.edu.cn/laihua or www.campuschina.org and click "Application Online for International Students".
- Step 2: Read "Tips for online application" carefully before clicking "NEXT" to the registration page.
- Step 3: Log in with your user name and password. For new user, please click "Create an account" for registration.
- Step 4: Fill in the correct Program Category and Agency Number. An Agency Number represents a specific application receiving agency and a correct choose of Program Category is necessary before filling in the Agency Number. Please make sure you fill it in correctly, otherwise you will not be able to continue your online application or your application will not be accepted.
- Your 'Program Category' is : <u>Type A</u> and 'Agency Number' is: <u>7051</u>. Once the correct 'Agency Number' is entered, the name of the agency will automatically emerge.
- Step 5: Fill in the Online Application Form and Upload Supporting Documents truly, correctly and completely following the steps listed on the left of the page.
- Applicants are required to select a discipline before choosing their majors. Please refer to the Disciplines Index, which could be downloaded from Help, if you have any doubt about the disciplines and majors.
- Step 6: Check each part of your Application carefully before submitting it. Click Submit to submit your Application.
- Step 7: You can make changes to your application by clicking Withdraw and Edit the Application on the top of the page. But make sure to submit it again by clicking Submit after finishing all the changes. Otherwise, the retrieved application will become invalid and your new application will not be received either.
- Step 8: Download the completed Application Form by clicking *Print the Application Form* and print two hard copies.
- Step 9: Prepare other supporting documents as required and send the full package of application documents (in duplicate) to the dispatching authorities.

Program Introduction

For the academic year 2017/2018, the Ministry of Education, P. R. China will entrust 7 leading Chinese universities such as Peking University with 8 Master's degree programs, namely The Master of Laws (LL.M.) Program in Chinese Law, International Program on Master of Public Health (IMPH), Master of International Economic Cooperation, Master of China Studies, The LL.M Program in International Economic Law, MBA Program, AllB Master of International Finance, Master of One-Belt-Road Sustainable Infrastructure Engineering. The programs duration will be one year or two years (1+1), and will be open to applicants from 56 developing countries.

The Master of Laws (LL.M.) Program in Chinese Law	1 Year	Peking University	The Master of Laws (LL.M.) Program in Chinese Law is a graduate-level law program offered by the Law School, Peking University, focusing on Chinese civil and commercial law. The language of instruction is English. It goes with China's national strategy of One Belt and One Road, aiming to provide talent support for accelerating the economic development and regional economic integration of Asian countries, as well as to reserve talent resources for AIIB to develop its continuous core competence among international multilateral financing institutions. The program is focused to train policy makers and executors with global vision for regional cooperation, financial administrative talents to accelerate the integration of Asian economy, and entrepreneurs to promote the communication and cooperation within Asia.
Master's Program of One-Belt-Road Sustainable Infrastructure Engineering (MOSI)	2 Years (1+1)	Southeast University	English-taught MOSI is designed for senior civil servants of countries along "One Belt One Road", especially the senior officials in Ministry of Communications, Construction and Business, senior managers of related organizations and enterprises, and technical experts of universities and scientific research institutions. The program aims to train regional construction policy makers and executors with global strategy and the idea of sustainable development, as well as to cultivate senior managers and high-tech talents of modern infrastructure construction.

Note: "1+1" studies refers to one year course study in China and one year dissertation composition in home countries. Dissertation defense will take place in China at the end of the study.

Enrollment Quota, Program Duration and Medium of Instruction

- " A one-year full-time Master's degree program
- " 30-35 students per class
- " Academic year from September, 2017
- " Courses all taught in English

Scholarship Coverage

1. One-year Program

Total Amount: 200,800 RMB per year for each student, covering:

- " Exempted fees: registration fees, tuition fees, laboratory experiment fees, internship fees, and fees for basic learning materials.
- " On-campus accommodation.
- " Living Allowance (96,000 RMB per year for each student).
- " One-off settlement subsidy after registration (3,000 RMB for each student).
- " Comprehensive medical insurance.
- " A one-way air ticket to China upon registration and a one-way air ticket back from China to the student's home country after completion of the study.

2. Two-year Program (1+1 studies)

Scholarship for the first academic year is the same as One-year Program. In the second academic year, students will do their thesis back in their home countries and the dissertation defense in China, while the scholarship will only cover one round-trip ticket for dissertation defense.

Application Receiving Agency and Deadline

The applicants should submit their applications during the application period to the Chinese Embassy in their countries of nationality, or to the 7 program universities. Please contact the Embassies or universities for the

specific deadlines for 2017 applications.

Qualifications

Qualifications for an eligible applicant include:

- 1. Healthy both physically and mentally; not over 45 years old (born after September 1, 1972).
- 2. A bachelor or higher degree, at least 3 years' work experience, some educational or professional experience in a field relative to that of the program applied.
- 3. Working in a government agency, company or research institute, and being a Section Director or Chief of Office, a senior manager, or excellent in scientific researches.
- 4. Good English language proficiency, able to follow English-taught courses well. Minimum requirements for reference: IELTS (Academic) total score 6.0, or TOEFL Internet score 80.
- 5. Having a strong development potential in his/her career, and willing to promote the mutual cooperation and exchanges between China and his/her home country.
- 6. Students who are now studying in China or already winners of Chinese Government Scholarship are not allowed to apply.

Step 2: Documents Submission

the application receiving agency.

Application Documents

Please scan the following materials IN ORDER into one document and ensure clarity.

- " Application form with a 2-inch photo and the applicant's signature.
- " Personal statement of research (A minimum of 500 words in English).
- " Copies of bachelor's degree certificate(s) and academic transcript(s).
- " Two recommendation letters from the applicant's employers and/or professors. Telephone numbers and email addresses of the referees must be included in the letters.
- " Employment verification.
- " English proficiency certificates.
- " Copy of the passport page of personal information (Ordinary Passport for Private Affairs only)

Note: Scanned copies of the documents will be sufficient during the application period. Originals or verified copies will be required upon enrollment at the universities. All documents should be in Chinese or English and are not retrievable.

Admission Notification

- 1. Application documents will be reviewed by Admission Committee, and outstanding applicants will be selected.
- 2. Each applicant will be supported by the scholarship for one program only.
- 3. The universities or the Chinese Embassy will send the Admission Letter and Visa Application Form for Study in China (JW201) to the scholarship winners.
- 4. If a successful applicant fails to register for the programs before the deadline, the entitlement to the scholarship will be cancelled.
