## **Predstavitev predloga pobude Slovenia Global Development Fellowship Initiative**



### **Slovenia Global Development Fellowship Initiative**

Global Development (GD), in collaboration with the Permanent Mission of the Republic of Slovenia to the United Nations and the University of Ljubljana, are introducing a new Fellowship Initiative for Slovenian Masters students to develop skills and experience within some of the leading international organizations based in Geneva, Switzerland

These fellowships will provide a unique opportunity to Slovenian students to get acquainted with the leading international organizations which are strategically important for Slovenia's economy and global prosperity. The Fellowship Initiative will also enrich the students' knowledge about the importance of global health, innovations, intellectual property and telecommunications in today's interconnected world. At the same time, this initiative will offer the hosting organizations the opportunity to promote their activities to a future generation of professionals and leaders.

This public-private initiative will make available three-month summer fellowships in Geneva-based international organizations for three students every year, over a period of three years, starting in the summer of 2016. The University of Ljubljana, the leading university in Slovenia, will assess and select the strongest candidates for the fellowships.

#### **Mission:**

Provide Slovenian Masters students with a unique global platform to foster new collaborations, develop knowledge and exchange solutions on current global issues.

#### **Founding Partners:**

#### **Hosting International Organizations:**

The Fellowship Initiative has been introduced in the following United Nations agencies that will serve as host organizations:

- World Health Organization (WHO),
- International Telecommunication Union (ITU)

#### **Sponsors and Strategic Partners:**

The initiative will be supported by the Founding Partners and the leading innovative enterprises in Slovenia, based on the transparent guiding principles.

#### **Launch and Communication:**

The launch of the Fellowship Initiative and the selection process is envisioned for early 2016,



and candidates will debut in Geneva in the summer of 2016. An interactive website, Facebook and Twitter will offer platforms to share experiences and promote the initiative to students and a wider audience.

## Plan of Activities 2015/16:

Initial discussions have already taken place with the Founding Partners and the hosting UN agencies in 2015. All three UN agencies have received this Initiative with great enthusiasm, and are developing Terms of Reference for prospective candidates.

- Develop initiative project plan 2015/16 (*Sept – Dec 2015*)
  - Identify roles – founding partners and UN agencies
  - Identify activities and agree on governance – founding partners and UN agencies
  - Develop student selection criteria and fellowship description
  - Develop detailed plan, timeline and milestones, including launch event
  - Develop funding budget for Fellowship, operations and communication
  - Mobilize financial resources from a diverse and a balanced group of public and private partners
  - Develop a communication strategy and plan for target audiences, including reporting
- Sign Letter of Collaboration (*Jan 2016*)
- Launch of Fellowship Initiative at an event relevant to all students and partners in Slovenia (*TBC*)
- Student application process announced (*Feb 2016*)
- Beginning of the Fellowships in Geneva (*Jun 2016*)
- Communication, final report on Fellowships 2016 and preparation for 2017 (*Sept 2016*)
- Sharing experience and launching 2017 Fellowships at the Young Bled Strategic Forum, or other appropriate events agreed with partners (*Sept 2016*)
