

In 2022, the Financial Times' top 5 masters in finance are 100% French.


The University Paris-Saclay is ranked 3rd for mathematics, and 9th in physcis

The individual enrolment

For a first year of bachelor:





To be noted: Some institutions do not yet offer their courses on Parcoursup. In this case, contact the institution directly to find out about the registration procedures.

From the second year of the bachelor's degree, master's degree and doctorate:

- No particular procedure: contact the institution directly
- Consult the <u>Campus France catalogues</u> to find a course
- To increase your chances of admission, it is recommended that you apply to at least three different institutions
- Responses are usually sent to applicants between 15 June and 15 September for a start in September/October of the same year







Erasmus Programme

Prerequisites

- Be enrolled at a Slovenian university
- 1 Erasmus per study cycle (1 or 2 semesters)
- French level B1 B2



Tuition fees

The cost of studying in France is one of the lowest in the world. European students pay the same tuition fees as French students.

The language level required

A **B1 or B2 level** in French is generally required **for studies in French** at Bachelor and Master levels. Some institutions may require a C1 or C2 level. Foreign students must present a document attesting to their level in French (DELF, DALF, TCF or TEF).

For courses in English, mastery of French is not required, but mastery of English is.

Programmes in cooperation with the Faculty of law

- Summer University of French and European Law organized by the faculty of law of Ljubljana and the faculty of law from Poitiers

Concrete examples

Tanja is a Slovenian high school senior. She learned French during her studies and has a B2 level. She would like to study languages in France at university for her first year of bachelor.

- November January: Get information about universities, programmes and cities of study using the resources of Campus France.
- January April: Registration on the Parcoursup platform, choice of universities, filling in applications.
- June: Admission replies from universities.
- **June September**: Administrative procedures (registration at the university, housing, social security, travel to France...).

For students who reside in Europe but are **not nationals of a European country**: to enrol in France for the first year of a bachelor's degree programme they must submit a **Prior Admission Application (DAP)**. This must be done between October and January preceding the academic year in which they wish to begin their studies in France.







Concrete examples

Marko is a first year Master student at the University of Ljubljana. He does not speak French, but has a C1 level in English. He wants to study finance in France in a top school for his second year of Master.

- October December: Contact directly the universities or schools you are interested in, as every school has its own requirements and selection procedures.
- Winter Spring: Applications and interviews.
- June July : Admission replies from universities.
- **July October**: Administrative procedures (registration at the university, housing, social security, travel to France...).
- → To enrol in a university in France from the second year of bachelor, do not hesitate to contact the universities early in the year to find out about their admission criteria and their admission calendar.







Law program for foreign students – Panthéon Paris Assas

The University of Paris-Panthéon-Assas offers legal courses reserved for international students, the University Higher Diplomas (DSU).

- Introduction to French law (public and private)
- Tutorials in French legal methodology
- Lectures on the law of the chosen specialisation (6 existing specialisations)
- Tutorials in French language

Admission requirements

- Hold a law degree obtained in a foreign institution and judged to be at least equivalent to a Master 1 (French master)
- Have a minimum level of French B2 (for non-French speaking candidates)

Applications between 15 March and 14 April 2023







Concrete examples

Barbara is a second Master student at the University of Ljubljana. She wants to obtain a **PhD in France in chemistry.**

- Identify the scientific field and the **Doctoral Schools** and research organisations concerned by this theme. Visit their website and/or the Campus France research portal to apply on the online offers or propose a subject.
- Contact the thesis director with a research project proposal.
- **Find funding** or check that the subject is funded. It can be funded by the doctoral school, by your national government, by a company or by the European Union.
- After agreement on the subject of the thesis, apply to the doctoral school and register.















Financing your stay

Cost of living in France

The cost of living in France is quite high, especially in Paris and the big cities. **Some examples:**

- Accomodation :
 - 250€ to 650€ per month in a university residence
 - 400€ to 600€ per month in a private student residence (outside of Paris)
 - Other possibilities: private rental, shared accommodation, homestay State aid (CAF - APL/ALS): up to 260€ per month
- Food : about 300€ per month
- Meals at the university restaurant: 3,25€.
- Health:
 - Free social security coverage with the European Health Insurance Card
 - Consultation with a general practitioner: €25 (€16.50 reimbursed)
- Transportation : around 30€ per month
- Leisures (discounts for students):
 - Admission to the cinema : 5€ to 7,50€
 - Admission to the museum : 5€ to 15€, or free







Financing your stay

French Government Scholarship Program (BGF)

The French Institute of Slovenia offers French Government Scholarships:

- For Bachelor and Master levels :
- 700 € per month, for a stay of 10 months (September 2023 June 2024)
- Eligibility requirements: Slovenian nationality, under 30 years old, accepted in a Bachelor or Master course in a French institution

Procedure

- End of January 2023: publication of the call for applications
- End of April 2023: deadline for applications
- May 2023: selection interviews and announcement of results.

Sudying in France: an asset

France is the 6th largest economy in the world (2nd in Europe).

France has a high level of research:

- 5th country in the world in terms of domestic spending on research and development
- 42% of doctoral students registered in France are foreigners

France is a favourable environment for innovation and young entrepreneurs:

 France is the second most innovative European nation and two-thirds of research in France is conducted in the private sector

France is attractive to foreign investors:

France is Europe's first destination for international investments in 2020

French is an international language:

- French is the world's fifth most widely spoken language in the world, and the most studied language after English
- Official language in almost 30 countries
- 3rd business language, 4th language of the internet

If you speak French, you can work:

- in France
- in a French company (Renault, Servier, Poclain, Decathlon...) based in Slovenia
- in a Slovenian company/organisation linked to international cooperation (Ministry, university, STA press agency, European Agencies...).

Professional opportunities

Internships

Employers generally require a B2/C1 level of French.

Procedure for an internship in France:

- apply early (from February for a summer internship)
- an internship agreement must be signed between the higher education institution, the host organisation and the student
- for an internship lasting more than 2 months, the student must be paid a minimum of €3.90 per hour (about €600 per month)
- the internship lasts a maximum of 6 months.
