







ROUND TABLE: The Use of Veto Power in R2P Situations

Round table will address the right to veto as a potential obstacle to more efficient work of the United Nations Security Council, including in the context of reform proposals. Debate will focus on the use of Veto Power in **Responsibility to Protect** (R2P) situations. It will address current pressing issues, such as conflict in Syria and Middle East.
