

Tax Law Seminar – Invitation to apply

At the beginning of October, the Faculty of Law will host Prof. Michal Radvan, a professor of Financial Law at the Faculty of Law, Masaryk University.

Prof. Radvan will be holding a Seminar on Tax Law, which will cover two main topics:

1. Taxation of new types of incomes (such as influencers or Airbnb):

With the increasing role of information technologies, the problems of taxing specific types of incomes may occur. The lecture will focus mainly on the taxation of influencers and Airbnb providers. We will talk about the types of incomes of influencers, and we will try to identify whether the current legal regulation is general enough to tax their incomes correctly. In the case of Airbnb accommodation, we will focus on the definition of short-term accommodation service and long-term rent so that we can compare the level of taxation.

2. Property taxation:

Property taxes are meager in all Central and Eastern European Countries. We can see that national legislators are trying to find new ways and approaches to property taxation. During the lecture, we will discuss several issues: what type of property should be taxed and who should be the taxpayer. We have to decide whether an area-based system or an ad valorem system is more appropriate for our region. We will talk about exemptions from taxation, tax administration, and the role of recurrent property tax revenues for local budgets.

The Seminar will take place at the Faculty on Tuesday, 10 October, from 10 a.m. (Seminar Room 5), and on Wednesday, 11 October, from 16 p.m. (Seminar Room 2). The Seminar is open to all students at the Faculty, including Erasmus exchange students. The Seminar will be held in English.

Seminar iz davčnega prava – vabilo k prijavi

V začetku oktobra bo Pravna fakulteta gostila prof. Michala Radvana, profesorja finančnega prava na Pravni fakulteti Marasykove Univerze v Brnu.

Prof. Radvan bo v času obiska izvedel dvodelni seminar iz davčnega prava, ki bo pokril dve temi:

1. Obdavčitev novih oblik dohodka (npr. obdavčitev vplivnežev, Airbnb):

Zaradi vse večje vloge informacijskih tehnologij se lahko pojavijo težave pri obdavčevanju posebnih vrst dohodkov. Predavanje bo osredotočeno predvsem na obdavčitev vplivnežev in ponudnikov Airbnb. Govorili bomo o vrstah dohodkov vplivnežev in poskušali ugotoviti, ali je veljavna pravna ureditev dovolj splošna za pravilno obdavčitev njihovih dohodkov. V primeru nastanitev prek Airbnb se bomo osredotočili na opredelitev storitve kratkoročne nastanitve ter dolgoročnega najema in primerjali ravni obdavčitve.

2. Obdavčitev premoženja:

Davki na premoženje so v vseh srednje- in vzhodnoevropskih državah nizki. Vidimo lahko, da nacionalni zakonodajalci poskušajo najti nove načine in pristope k obdavčitvi premoženja. Na predavanju bomo razpravljali o več vprašanjih: katere vrste premoženja je treba obdavčiti in kdo naj bo davčni zavezanc. Ukvarjali se bomo z vprašanjem, ali je za našo regijo primernejši sistem na podlagi površine (specifični) ali sistem ad valorem davka. Govorili bomo o oprostitvah obdavčitve, davčni upravi in vlogi ponavljačih se prihodkov od davka na premoženje za lokalne proračune.

Seminar bo potekal v torek, 10. oktobra, od 10. ure (v Seminarju 5) ter v sredo, 11. oktobra od 16. ure (v Seminarju 2) dalje. Prijave so odprte za vse študentke in študente Pravne fakultete, vključno z Erasmus študenti. Seminar bo potekal v angleškem jeziku.
