Uvod

V četrtek in petek 28. in 29. junija 2012 je na Pravni fakulteti Univerze v Ljubljani, pod organizacijskim vodstvom doc. dr. Vasilke Sancin, potekala Prva konferenca o sodobnih izvivih mednarodnega okoljskega prava (*First Contemporary Challenges of International Environmental Law Conference*). Oblikovana je bila kot interdisciplinarno srečanje, ki je povezalo znanstvenike s posameznimi naravoslovnih in tehničnih področij z mednarodnopravnimi strokovnjaki v skupni razpravi in iskanju tehničnih zamisli o novih mednarodnopravnih rešitvah. Konferenca je ocenila tudi izide Konference Združenih narodov o trajnostnem razvoju, ki je potekala 20. – 22. junija 2012 v Rio de Janeiru (Rio+20).

Konferenco je odprl predsednik Republike Slovenije **dr. Danilo Türk**, uvodno predavanje pa je imela profesorica **dr. Lučka Kajfež Bogataj** (članica IPCC in sodobitnica Nobelove nagrade za mir leta 2007). Kot osrednji gost je svoja spoznanja predstavil profesor **dr. Philippe Sands**, svetovna avtoriteta za področje mednarodnega okoljskega prava.

V okviru konference je izšla tudi knjiga v angleškem jeziku z naslovom **International Environmental Law: Contemporary Concerns and Challenges** (urednica dr. Vasilka Sancin).




Udeleženci


Svoje referate je v tematskih panelih predstavilo 29 referentov, poleg tega pa je bilo izvedenih tudi 6 predstavitev plakatov.





Zaključki konference

Predsednik Republike Slovenije dr. Danilo Türk je izrazil **razočaranje nad izidom konference Rio+20**. Poudaril je, da besedilo sklepnega dokumenta konference Rio+20, imenovano *The Future We Want*, vsebuje zgolj izraze polne aspiracij, **brez jasno določenih in začrtanih ciljev in obveznosti držav za odpravo revščine po svetu in dostop do trajnostnih in učinkovitih virov energije**.

Ena nujnih sprememb za učinkovitejšo vključitev držav in nosilcev odločanja v pogajanja o okolju, ki jo je omenil dr. Türk, je **institucionalna reforma**, ki bi zagotovila višjo stopnjo institucionalne skladnosti s politično strukturo na mednarodni ravni ter tako pritegnila nosilce odločanja k pogajanjem in sprejemu mednarodnih pravnih aktov. Po besedah dr. Türk, bi **regulacija na mednarodni ravni postavila jasnejše obveznosti in okvire delovanja za države, podjetja ter druge akterje**, kar bi bilo predvsem **pozitivno za razvoj »zelene ekonomije«**. Ob tem je dr. Türk predstavil potrebo po **vključitvi etike v politično voljo in procese odločanja** ter potrebo po **dvigu človeškega dostenjanstva** in stopnje spoštovanja pravnih norm, ki varujejo to dostenjanstvo.



Podobno ugotovitev o **nujnosti sprememb na ravni vrednot družbe** je predstavila tudi dr. Lučka Kajfež Bogataj. Kot je poudarila, strokovna spoznanja kažejo, da bomo **z načinom življenja in izrabe naravnih virov že kmalu presegli regenerativno sposobnost narave**. Dr. Kajfež Bogatajeva je pojasnila, da je **družbena blaginja mogoča tudi brez gospodarske rasti** ter da je nastopal čas za novo makro-ekonomijo, ki podpira trajnostni razvoj. Za dosego tega pa so potrebne predvsem kulture spremembe, kot se je izrazila referentka. Kulturne spremembe v smislu

preoblikovanja našega skupnega razumevanja vrednot, ki bodo morale temeljiti bolj na moralnih in etičnih vrednotah ter enotnem razumevanju družbe. Le z enotnim razumevanjem družbe in skupnosti bomo lahko uspešno reševali najtežje skupne probleme varovanja okolja, je še opozorila dr. Kajfež Bogatajeva.

Prav tako je profesor dr. Philippe Sands z razočaranje ugotovil, da **od prve konference Združenih narodov o trajnostnem razvoju v Rio de Janeiru leta 1982 mednarodna skupnost na področju varstva okolja ni uspela doseči večjega napredka**, predvsem pa ne sprememb v ravnanju držav. Poudaril je, da **sistem oblikovanja pravno zavezajočih norm mednarodnega okoljskega prava ne deluje**, prav tako pa je **mednarodni**



sodni sistem nepripravljen sprejeti ustreznih odločitev, ki bi lahko vplivale na spremembe v ravnjanju držav.

V svojem razmišljjanju je dr. Sands **razvoj mednarodnega okoljskega prava povezal z razvojem prava človekovih pravic**. Izrazil **je upanje, da ne bo šele naravna katastrofa velikih in grozovitih razsežnosti države prepričala v spremembo ravnanja**, kot so to na področju prava človekovih pravic povzročile šele grozovitosti v republikah nekdanje Jugoslavije in Ruandi.

O nujnosti sprememb ravnanja posameznikov, gospodarskih subjektov in držav so se strinjali tudi vsi drugi referenti in udeleženci konference.



Pomen konference

First Contemporary Challenges of International Environmental Law Conference postavlja pomemben kamen v mozaik razvoja mednarodnega okoljskega prava. Kot se je izrazil dr. Sands predstavlja konferenca novo platformo za naslavljjanje okoljskih vprašanj. Poudaril pa je tudi, da se bo ob pozitivnih vtisih s konference v Ljubljani mednarodno okoljsko pravo razvijalo v pravo smer.


